As Trish indicated, we need a Change of Status form on him showing he is no longer on military deployment and has returned to JCC Nampa as a full time employee. On the separation form, way down at the bottom it shows name change, etc, the last one is "Other" Check that box, indicate he has returned from deployment and is actively employed with JCCN.

Then the last part of the process is David gathering all his documentation that he completed the terms of his sentencing, completion of the alcohol course, community service, and he has documentation of the case being closed. You might check the repository for some of that. As soon as you have all the paperwork, scan and send over to me, and I will ask that he return to the Hearing Board , hopefully the December 11th Hearing Board. Mr. Flink and Trish,

I wanted to bring you up to date on David Lewis, Juvenile Corrections Nampa Direct Care Staff.

In June he appeared in front of the POST Hearing Board on background issues.

His current charge, (M) Battery, occurred in August 2009. He pled guilty, received one year unsupervised probation, 16 hour alcohol course, and 24 hours community service.

At the June Hearing Board, the Board recommended waiver on the condition Mr. Lewis report to the Council by November 15th, 2010 of his completion of probation and terms of probation.

A couple things I wanted to update you on:

1. Mr. Lewis' probation did not expire until December 5th, 2010, therefore could not report to the Council by November 15th on completion, so the Council could hear it on the December 2nd Meeting.
2. Most importantly, Mr. Lewis was deployed September 17th, 2010 for 12 months. His change of status is in skills.

Although he could have reported his status up prior to his deployment in September, he would not have been able to complete probation in the time given by POST Council. My Superintendent's question is this: What if anything does POST Council need from her so that when he returns, he can report to Council, and in what manner? Does POST Council need a letter from the Superintendent explaining this?
