On 5/18/10 @ about 12:50pm I entered classroom 3 to assist with a helping circle for IS. IS decided to leave classroom 3 and not participate in his helping circle. I stood in his way and tried to stop him from leaving classroom 3. He tried to push me out of the way. A code red was called @ 12:51pm while Buckles, Higgins, McNally and I wrestled IS to the floor. After a few minutes IS started banging his head on the floor so we got McNally's jacket to put under IS's head. It was then decided to put mechanical restraints on IS and move him to Solutions SM1 for both staff and IS's safety @ 12:55pm. || ACTION TAKEN: Restrained, mechanical restraints applied (cuffs and leg irons), came to Solutions SM1, and then moved to his room in [REDACTED]

Hello Everyone,

It was nice to see some of you when I stopped in for a visit today. After seeing the shock on a few of your faces, I thought it was wise to give the rest of you a heads up on where things are in relation to my recovery. I am currently doing really well. Most of my brain is functioning at or near the pre-injury state; having said that, I haven't quite fine tuned my ability to verbally communicate clearly. My speech has and will continue to improve with speech therapy and time. In the mean time, RT and my doctors have agreed to allow me to return to work part-time to work on things outside the classroom. I will be returning this Monday and will work Monday, Wednesday, and Friday and gradually increase my hours as my therapy schedule and health allows.

On a slightly different note, I did bump into several of the juveniles while I was there today. I feel like I left them with many questions and concerns and that's not cool. I will be writing a letter to them to explain the situation either tonight or tomorrow. Once complete, I will send it to RT so he can forward it to whoever is best suited to share it with them. I am more than willing to answer any questions anyone has, so don't be afraid to ask. However, it might be easier for the time being, to do it through e-mail; as I can type faster and clearer than I can speak.

I hope this clears things up a bit for everyone. Thanks again for all of your thoughts and prayers! And a big thank you to all of the education staff that has and continues to keep things running smoothly during my absence. I can't wait to be able to return to teaching and will continue to work as hard as I can until I can do so.
